We are pleased to announce that Dr. Gordon Neufeld will be in Winnipeg March 30-April 3rd, 2009 to offer his five day Level One Intensive. This course has been offered in Vancouver and Montreal for nearly a decade, and now after many requests as this approach grows in Winnipeg, Dr. Neufeld has agreed to bring his foundational course directly to us. Dr. Neufeld is booked two years in advance, so this course will not be offered here again for some time.

Course Content & Objectives:

The Level One Intensive provides the conceptual foundations of Dr. Neufeld's attachment-based developmental paradigm. Participants are equipped to use the constructs of attachment, maturation and vulnerability to view children and their problems three-dimensionally. From this base of perceptive insight doors can be opened to deep-rooted change. Participants will learn to recognize the signs of stuckness, to determine the causes of this state, and to reverse this condition.

Course participants are also equipped to use a working model of attachment that can be applied to children of all ages and levels of challenge, to assess for the appropriate depth and development of attachment, and to employ strategies for cultivating a context of connection with the immature.

Recommended For:

Typical participants include superintendents, teachers, school administrators, psychologists, psychiatrists, family service providers, counselors, social workers, physicians, nurses, university professors, play therapists, marriage and family therapists, day-care providers, early childhood educators, clergy, youth workers, probation officers and staff of residential programs for troubled kids, and anyone else involved in the lives of children and families. Parents who are comfortable with a university level approach to the subject will also greatly benefit
