

## 12 Internet Safety Rules

1. **ALWAYS** provide an alias or nickname that does not reveal anything about you
2. **NEVER** give your photo, name, phone number, home address or email address, the location of your school, your parent's address and phone number at their work, or their credit card number
3. **ALWAYS** respect others' privacy and feelings
4. **NEVER** open emails, files, links, images or games from people you do not know or do not trust
5. **ALWAYS** keep an eye on those who want desperately to be your friend
6. **ALWAYS** avoid situations that make you feel uncomfortable, such as intimidation or harassment. Tell a responsible adult immediately
7. **NEVER** use language in chat rooms that you would not use in public
8. **ALWAYS** choose a password that is hard to guess, but easy for you to remember
9. **NEVER** give out personal information about yourself or anyone else in a chat room
10. **ALWAYS** be extremely careful online
11. **NEVER** agree to meet someone you met on the internet without talking about them with a responsible adult who will go with you, if you decide to go
12. **NEVER** reveal your password to anybody, not even with your best friends
