****Remember – joining the patrols requires commitment. If you agree to be a part of our Patrol Team, it is expected that you will remain a patrol for the entire school year.****

For students who are new to the patrol team and/or have not received training in the past, Mrs. Pereles will show them a new patrol training video on Friday, May 29 over the lunch hour and will take them for an on-site training session at a patrol corner on Monday, June 1 at 8:30 a.m.. On-site training sessions will continue with our current student patrols during regular patrol hours every day from June 2-17. No training will take place June 11 and 12 during the Grade 5/6 overnight camp.

Regular patrol hours are: 8:40-9:00 a.m. 3:25-3:40 p.m.

Students will be chosen for the patrol teams after they have successfully completed the training sessions. The new patrol team will effectively begin June 18 for the remainder of the school year. New captains and lieutenants will be chosen over the next couple of weeks. We will attempt to accommodate bus students' schedules where possible. If students are only available in the morning or afternoon, they may find a partner who is available the other time. A Constable, from Community Services School Resources Unit of the Winnipeg Police will meet with the new patrols in the fall.
