
Did You Know?

- ◆ Pluto is named after the god of the under world
- ◆ Pluto is the 9th planet from the sun
- ◆ Pluto is the smallest planet in the solar system with the diameter of 2,284 km
- ◆ Pluto's only moon Charon was discovered 48 years after Pluto itself was discovered
- ◆ Charon, Pluto's only moon, has the diameter of 200 km
- ◆ Pluto's average temperature is 370 degrees Celsius
- ◆ Pluto's extreme temperature's is due to its distance from the sun
- ◆ Pluto's distance from the sun is 5,913,520,000 km
- ◆ Pluto was discovered in 1930 by an American named Clyde Tombaugjh
- ◆ a day in Pluto is a 6 x longer than a day in Earth
- ◆ but a year in in Pluto is longer than a human's life, which is 248.54 Earth years
- ◆ Pluto's atmosphere is composed of 3 frozen gases primarily of frozen liquid nitrogen and smaller portions of frozen methane and frozen carbon monoxide
- ◆ Pluto's looks like a circular partly ice/partly non-icy rock
- ◆ Pluto is 300% gas 700% rock

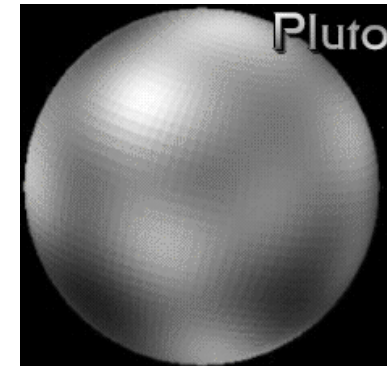
